DJAZAGRO: A TRADE FAIR SUPPORTING THE ALGERIAN AGRI-FOOD INDUSTRY

The Djazagro trade fair took place from Sunday 12 to Wednesday 15 April at the Palais des Expositions in Algiers (SAFEX), where exhibitors and visitors gathered to meet and exchange ideas.

Over the course of four days, **25,000 professionals** from across Algeria and abroad came together with a shared goal: to drive the agri-food industry forward. Both at the stands and in the aisles, discussions flourished, connections were made and projects took shape.

Among the players in the agri-food industry, **600 exhibitors** representing **700 brands** from **28 different countries** were in attendance.

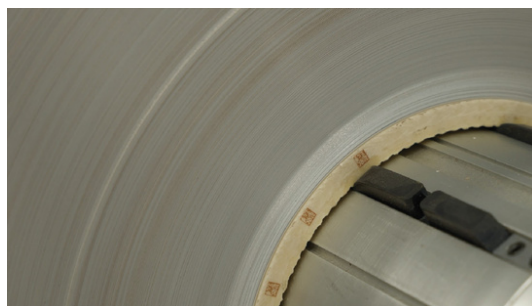
GOLD MEDAL

GOGLIO (ITALY)

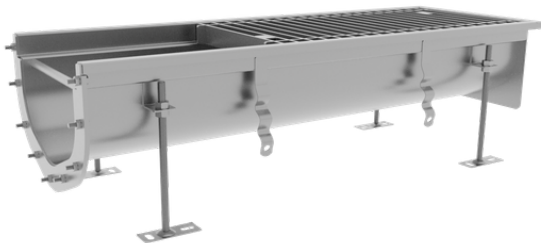

ACINOX (FRANCE)

PRODUCT: HYGIENIC DESIGN DRAIN

SECTOR: HEALTH AND SAFETY



Hygienic Design drainage channels help ensure reliable production by eliminating contamination. Hygienic Design drainage channels have been specially designed to meet two key objectives:

reduction in product recalls. Their deep-drawn technology provides a smooth, seamless finish with no corners or areas where residue can accumulate.

2 - reduce water consumption whilst ensuring a high standard of hygiene. They offer savings of up to 94%: just 3 to 4 litres are needed to process a specific amount of waste, compared with 96 litres for a standard system.

Constructed with reinforced wings made of epoxy resin or stainless steel, their installation kit and seals simplify installation, saving up to 13% in time thanks to pre-assembled components.

PROMEC SRL (ITALY)
PRODUCT: SYNCHROJET LINEAR COMBIBLOCK
Sector: Process

The innovation involves equipment fitted with a device that synchronises a linear preform blower for the production of PET bottles with a rotary bottling machine, using a chain-driven synchronisation mechanism fitted with special grippers designed to transfer the bottles by their necks.



It is an ideal solution for all types of products: still or carbonated, chilled or hot, with or without pulp, sensitive products (dairy, juices), food products (oil, sauces, etc.) or personal care products, even when using extremely lightweight bottles.

Hygiene standards are naturally guaranteed thanks to the high-temperature heating of the PET preforms and their direct transfer to the filler, which reduces the risk of contaminants in the bottles. Furthermore, the system offers great operational flexibility with reduced changeover times.

The Experts' Agora



Throughout the exhibition, the Experts' Agora was constantly busy. The conferences, organised in partnership with Agroligne, gave visitors the chance to discover the latest trends and news from the agri-food sector, thanks to presentations by recognised experts.

Among the various topics covered, current issues were highlighted, such as exports from Algeria, environmental challenges and innovations in the sector.

Djaz'Pack, the exhibition dedicated to packaging, has highlighted a strategic link in the agri-food value chain. Once again this year, it has cemented its position as a key event, positioning packaging as a genuine driver of competitiveness: it is crucial for promoting local produce, for international distribution, and for meeting environmental requirements.

Building on the success of the previous edition, Djazagro continued its commitment to skills development through its Training Zone.

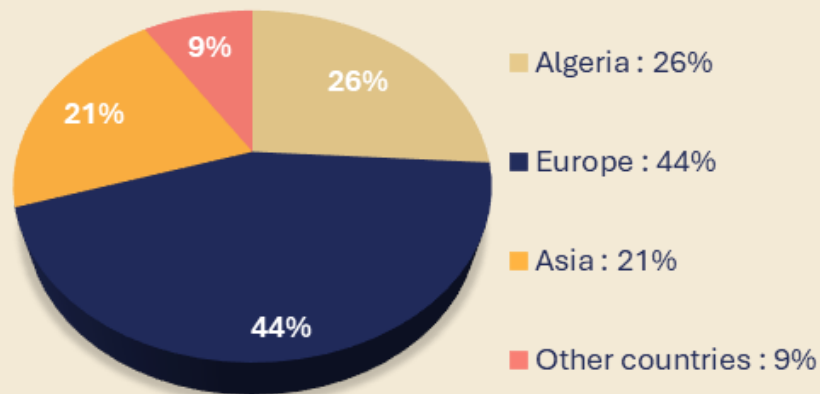
